Three Ways for Kids to end the School Year Strong

For most of us, where ever you may live, be it United States or Mexico, there's only about a month of school left. And many will probably consider summer session as a safe heaven just to ease the painful thought of trying to finish on time this school year.

These final days can be crazy busy! RIGHT? There are Class Days, small group tutor lead classes, sport events, and fun school-wide celebrations ahead. The whole winding down process provides many distractions to kids, and plenty of opportunity to slack off.

However, it's important to encourage your kids to end the school year strong.

Take it from a teacher's/ mom perspective-there is still much to be accomplished in those last 30 days.

Many of our small group classes or teacher lead mandatory classes are following a timeline to introduce learning standards or are finishing up end-of-year testing to measure academic growth in various subjects.





How can you keep your child on track? Here are three ideas.

1. Maintain your routine

Even though the weather is warming, and the grill and pool are calling your name, resist the temptation to stay up late playing outdoors. Instead, stick to your routines. They provide a predictability that help children feel safe. The same morning routine sets a calm start. Keeping homework time protected lends the child confidence. And going to bed at a consistent time will prevent exhaustion.

2. Keep a calendar

Visuals often help reduce children's stress. You can jot down upcoming fun events, like a field day, carnival, or field trip. Likewise note known testing dates and major homework assignment due dates. The night before, set goals for the next day so your child has a clear understanding of your expectations and their responsibilities.

As well at home with your personal work, If your child loses focus, he may miss important information or score lower than his potential on any of these assessments.

Emphasize the importance of doing your best

Sometimes, kids get the Im-almostdone bug and rush through their work at the end of the school year. You can encourage them to avoid making careless mistakes by attaching a checklist they can reference to a folder or other visible supply. Add things like, my name is on my paper, I showed my thinking, I re-read each question, I used my best handwriting. If desired, celebrate each box they checked off when they return home.



4. Trust your Lord and ask for his direction

Sometimes, We can also lose perspective of where we're at within so much that is needed to do at the end of the school year. Many of us are also tired and feel Overwhelmed when we see pages that probably have not been finished and we see the days check list nearing the final date. So much grading, correcting of work, writing assignments and oh so much stress!

This is the moment to remember to pray and ask the Lord to direct us every day. That our words will not be offensive to those around us who we love. For us to be patient with our children as they are also walking through this process of trying to finish.

Pray our Lord may be able to bring the peace to your home that is required during this time to fulfill his purpose for this year.

In all that we do, May we be able to honor him with our actions, our thoughts, and with our responsibility to finalize the goal in our children's academics.

Every moment checking our heart to be found in favor before our Lord.






